

## Fact vs. Fiction

**I can't vote because I forgot to register**

1

**FALSE.** In Michigan, you can register on Election Day.

**It's 8 p.m. and I am still in line. My vote won't count.**

**FALSE.** If you are in line by 8 p.m., you can vote and it will be counted.

**I only need my ID to vote.**

**FACT.** Bring your state provided ID for verification purposes.

**I can apply to vote absentee by mail or in-person.**

**FALSE.** You can apply for absentee ballots by mail, in-person or online. The last day to apply for a mailed ballot is October 31. Absentee ballots must be submitted by 8 p.m. on Election Day.

**I can use my phone at the voting booth.**

5

**FACT,** but with limitations. You can use your phone to research what is on the ballot. You cannot use your phone to:

- Take photos of the polling place or people there,
- Take photos of yourself with your ballot, or completed ballot.

**I can support a candidate in the polling place.**

**FALSE.** Michigan law prohibits campaign related items into the polling place.
